

WHAT'S A BAYOU CREW LEADER?

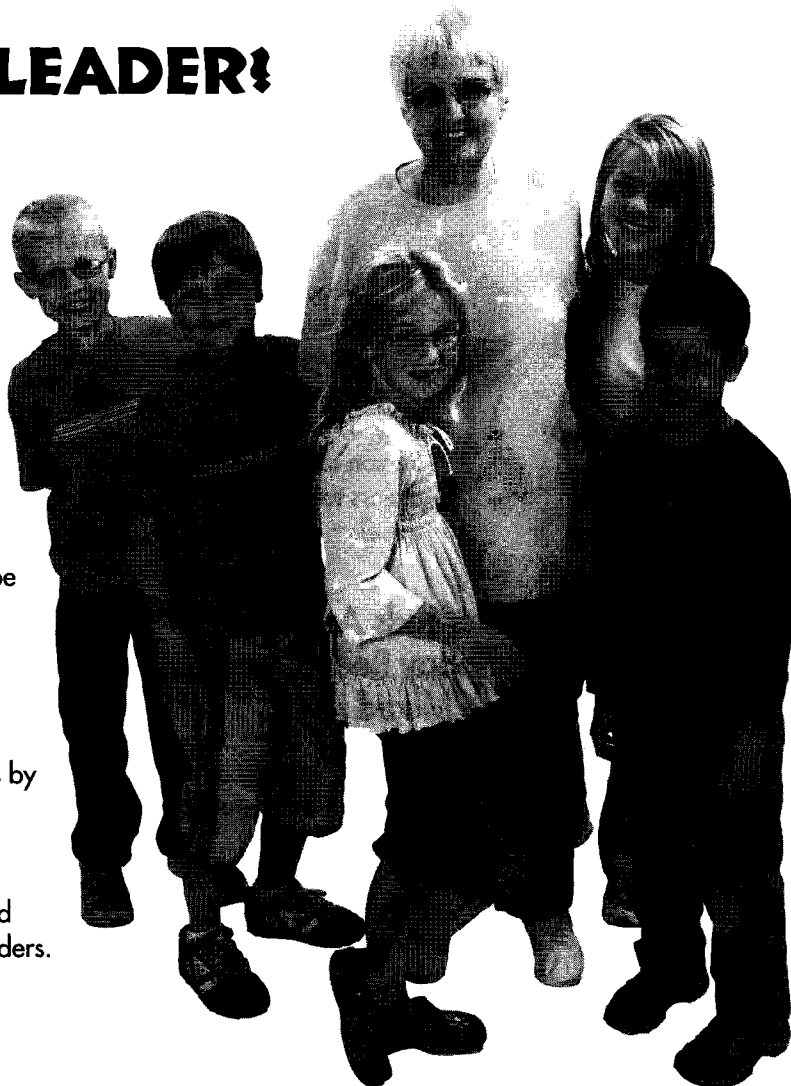
If you've been asked to be a Bayou Crew Leader, you've met two important qualifications: You love the Lord, and you love kids.

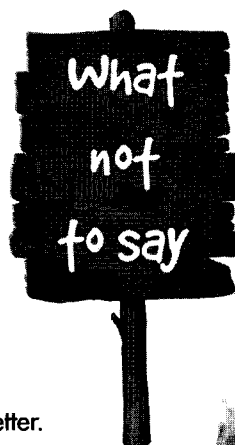
The following guidelines will help you be an awesome Bayou Crew Leader.

- ✦ That's a unique way of doing things! How did you think of that? Let's try it this way.
