Pastoral Care Ministries

_____ **Bereavement Minister** – companioning a grieving person as they go through the grieving process. Training 1½-2 hours a week for seven weeks on Tuesday evenings.

_____ **Homebound/Hospital Communion Minister** – bring Communion to the homebound/hospital every week, every other week, or once a month.

_____ **Jail Ministry Prayer Leader** – lead or assist at a prayer service at the jail on Sundays. Training provided.

_____ **Nursing Home Prayer Leader** – help lead prayer services at local nursing homes twice a month for 1 ½ hours.

_____ **Shawl Ministry** – an ancient ministry of knitting or crocheting shawls as prayer gifts to those who are ill, grieving or experiencing loss, new or nursing mother, etc.

_____ **Vigil Service Prayer Leader** – lead prayer service at local mortuaries as needed. Interview and training necessary.

Service Ministries

_____ **40+ Singles Ministry** – be involved in social justice/service while meeting other singles socially.

_____ **Family Table** – serve food, clean up, and offer hospitality to people in need every third Saturday of the month.

_____ **Funeral Lunch Helper** – setup, serve, and clean up meals served for funerals in FCC.

_____ **Loaves and Fishes Helper** – simple preparation of food, serving a meal, hospitality and clean up every third Tuesday at River of Life Lutheran Church in North Minneapolis.

_____ **Meals on Wheels** – deliver a hot meal from Mercy Hospital at noon to residents in Champlin/Anoka every seventh week. Current driver's license/proof of insurance required.

_____ **Women of Wonder** – a women's group who have informational meetings at the parish the 2nd Thursday of the month at 9:30 a.m. Childcare available.

_____ **Operation Hope** – group meets the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of month to make quilts and sew children's knit pajamas for needy individuals.

_____ **Ride Care Provider** – provide transportation to individuals for necessary dental/doctor appointments or to food shelf, etc.

_____ **W.H.O. Service Ministry** – meets every Wednesday at 8:30 a.m. in the Donovan/Romero Room for prayer and faith sharing. Assist church maintenance staff in campus tasks as well as outreach to elderly and ill with specific household chores.

_____ **Dust Angels** – Clean the interior of cars being donated by Free to Be. Commitment time 1-2 hours a month.
